

ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE VACATING WANDA LEA AVENUE,
A THOROUGHFARE IN THE CITY OF LAKEVIEW.

Whereas, a petition was duly filed with the Council of the City of Lakeview, Arkansas, on the 17 day of March, 1982, asking the said Council to vacate and abandon a certain thoroughfare known as Wanda Lea Avenue, as shown on the plat of the said City of Lakeview, Arkansas, and

Whereas, the Council has heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and has ascertained that the thoroughfare known as Wanda Lea Avenue has heretofore been dedicated to the public use as a street, but has not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five years subsequent to the filing of the plat; that the owners of the property abutting the thoroughfare to be vacated have filed their written consent to such abandonment and that the public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of said thoroughfare.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City of Council of the City of Lakeview, Arkansas:

Section 1. The City of Lakeview, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the thoroughfare designated as Wanda Lea Avenue, in said City of Lakeview, Baxter County, Arkansas.

Section 2. A copy of the ordinance, duly certified by the City Clerk, or Recorder, shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of Courts and ex-officio Recorder of Baxter County, Arkansas, and recorded in the deed records of the County.

Section 3. This ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, safety and welfare of the City of Lakeview, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
