

ORDINANCE NO. 58

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS FOR THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, Act 267 of 1949 permits municipalities by ordinance to adopt by reference technical codes, regulations and standards, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lakeview has complied with the provisions of this law by publishing a notice in the newspaper that three copies of the Traffic and Motor Vehicle Regulations for the State of Arkansas are on file in the Clerk or Recorder's office:

NOW, THEREFORE, the following ordinance is enacted:

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS FOR THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AS THE TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAKEVIEW, BAXTER CO., ARKANSAS.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEVIEW, BAXTER CO., ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the Traffic and Motor Vehicle Regulations for the State of Arkansas as contained in Vol. 6B of the Arkansas Statutes Annotated, three copies of which are on file in the Clerk or Recorder's Office, are hereby adopted as the traffic law and rules and regulations of the City of Lakeview, Baxter Co., Arkansas:

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3: Because of the need for uniformity of traffic laws throughout the City of Lakeview, and because of the great increase in traffic deaths and dangers on highways, this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
